Dear Chairman Baucus and Ranking Member Grassley:

We are writing to thank you for your leadership on and continued attention to improving health care access, coverage, and quality for all Americans. As organizations committed to ensuring that all of our nation's children are able to get the health coverage and medical services they need and deserve, we are pleased that the Senate Finance Committee has been exploring issues related to health reform through a series of meetings, hearings and other events. As you continue on this process of developing policy proposals to reform the nation's health care systems, we are writing to urge you to ensure that the unique health care needs of children are a priority in any health reform proposal you undertake in the remainder of the 110th Congress or in the coming 111th Congress.

Children are not just little adults. Their development is complex and their health care needs differ greatly from those of adults. As Congress embarks on health reform, it is important to remember children are not only our most precious national resource, they also represent one-third of the nation's non-Medicare population. The sad reality is that when it comes to large-scale system reform, too often, children are an afterthought. As your committee undertakes the task of reviewing and rethinking our nation's health care delivery systems, we urge you to ensure that the specific health concerns of children are taken into account as new policies are being developed.

We were proud to support the strong, bipartisan State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) reauthorization legislation which overwhelmingly passed Congress last year and we were disappointed that our collective efforts were insufficient to override a presidential veto. We look forward to continuing to work with you to get a strong and comprehensive SCHIP reauthorization across the finish line.

We are also hopeful that Congress, through health reform, will have an important opportunity to make significant strides to reduce the numbers of uninsured Americans, including the 8.8 million children who currently lack any form of health coverage and to ensure the special health concerns of children are addressed in health reform.

We appreciate your long-standing commitment to our nation's children, your leadership on SCHIP reauthorization, and all of your efforts to improve our nation's health care systems. We welcome the opportunity to work with you to develop policy proposals that are appropriate to meet children's unique needs and to ensure that all children have access to the health coverage they need and deserve.
